They came to inspect the water treatment plant because of the excellent water test numbers that our plant has been showing. They were very impressed with the simplicity of the plant (no electronics) and they thought that the price of the plant was very reasonable. They told our plant operator Kevin Wilson that our municipality was wise in not hooking up to the Portage water system because if it were to be compromised in any way too many people would be affected. They would prefer plants like ours across the province.

As a result of their visit another delegation came to Langruth. Representatives from the Department of Northern and Aboriginal Affairs and from the city of Thompson (driving all the way here and back in one day) and also representatives from some reserves visited our plant to investigate the possibility of having a plant like ours.

It has taken some time for our plant to be up and running smoothly. Now it is an example to others!
